

# Israeli Violations in the Occupied Palestinian Territory (OPT) 2014-2019

The International Criminal Court has jurisdiction over war crimes and crimes against humanity committed by Israel since 13 June 2014 – in this time, Israel has continued to establish and maintain illegal Israeli settlements, use excessive use of force against Palestinian civilians, pillage Palestinian natural resources, and subject the Palestinian people to an apartheid regime.

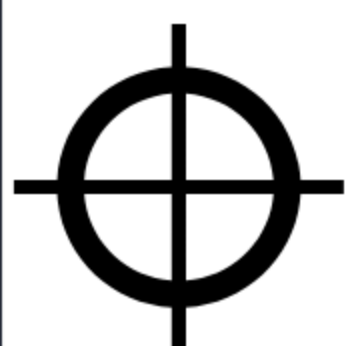
